It is being held in conjunction with the U.S. Minerals Management Service (MMS), Offshore Operators Committee, and several other industry associations.

The 1-½ day workshop has a unique purpose – to gather industry input about API's new Recommended Practice (RP) for Annular Casing Pressure Management for Offshore Wells. For the past year, a joint team of industry and MMS representatives has been working to develop this new RP, which focuses on offshore well systems. The document is under development by four teams of industry experts, with technical support from WJP Enterprises and DNV.

The workshop serves as an open forum for obtaining feedback about the RP from operators, contractors, and manufacturers. Assistance in facilitating this input will be provided by the Offshore Technology Research Center, a joint venture between University of Texas at Austin and Texas A&M University.
