The Active Lease DXF file was created using the standard ArcInfo DXF convert command - ARCDXF. This command converts an Arc/Info coverage into an AutoCADD Drawing Interchange file. The coordinates in the Arc/Info coverage were in longitude/latitude. Annotation was written to the output DXF file and was output as text entities. The DXF file contains no arcs. They were converted to line segments that approximate the arc. The DXF file is an ASCII file.

¹ArcInfo has no provisions to fix the width of a field on a DXF export. On the export the width is set to the actual size of the data in each field. The width shown is the width of the field in the TIMS attribute database. The data on this export should not exceed this width.

Annotation Column Definitions:

LEASE_NUMBER - The number assigned to a lease by the regulatory agency having jurisdiction over mineral activity in the territory where the lease is located.
